


## The Eyes Have It









## **Criss Cross**

When it comes to graphic eye liner, the more abstract the design the better. Use a precise, thin liner pen such as Topshop's Liquid Liner to create sharp edges.

## Half Moon

Create the illusion of wider eyes by drawing a half-moon crescent just above your eyelid crease. Those brave enough can try a bold, primary-coloured eyeliner, or choose a highly-pigmented black liner like Illamasqua's Illustrator pen.
